This exhibition charts the creative process as Charles Ritchie moves from journals to drawing and prints. Small in size and created in series, the drawings employ watercolor, graphite, and pen and ink. The prints are based on the artist's drawings and engage the techniques and materials of printmaking to reinvent the image. The artist's journals have been kept continuously since 1977 and are the springboard for many of his works.

Wednesday, October 1, 2008, 7pm Peter Turchi, professor in the MFA Program for Writers at Warren Wilson College, and author of The Sketchbooks, Drawings, and Prints of Charles Ritchie, will speak about Charles Ritchie's work.

This exhibition spotlights Gehry's Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles. Frozen Music tells the story of the building's design process, construction and completed form. The centerpiece of the exhibition is a series of more than 70 images by Gil Garcetti of the workers assembling the hall as well as images of the completed building. The exhibition organizer is the Virginia Center for Architecture, Richmond, Virginia.

Thursday, November 6, 2008, 7pm Frozen Music photographer Gil Garcetti will speak about his work.
